

Trunch Parish Council

The April meeting of Trunch Parish Council was held in the Methodist Church Meeting Room on Wednesday 6th April 2016. It was attended by eight Councillors and one member of the public.

PC Gwynn and PCSO Spinks came to speak to the Clerk and Chairman but did not stay for the meeting. They said that one crime of ASB Nuisance had been reported in the last month and that in future the Police reports to the Parish Council will be more comprehensive. PC Gwynn also reported that speed strips to check vehicle speeds would soon be positioned in the village.

Various potholes etc were discussed and chased up with Highways. But surprise surprise, North Walsham road has been marked up for repairs and when these have been carried out the road will be resurfaced.

A working group was formed to look at a large dip in the ground by the Wades Way entrance to the playing field and also the state of the access track to the allotments behind the Village Hall, to see what is required for repair. It was agreed that the Clerk would write to the owners of the land next to the track whose tenants use the track, informing them that the Parish Council intend to carry out work to repair the damage and asking for a contribution towards the cost of the work.

We are intending to set up a stand alone, more 'user friendly' website for the Parish Council. Hopefully this will be in place by the May meeting so I will be able to give you the details in next month's Mardle.
