

Trunch Parish Council

The May 2016 Meeting of Trunch Parish Council was held in the Methodist Church Meeting Room on Wednesday 4th May and was preceded by the 2016 Annual Meeting. It was attended by ten Parish Councillors and two members of the public.

At the meeting it was agreed that I be re-elected as Chairman and Councillor Leeder be re-elected as Vice- Chairman.

It was reported that the potholes on the North Walsham road have been repaired. All the NCC need to do now is solve the flooding problem. But at least it's a start.

The Clerk is waiting to hear from UK Network regarding the disconnection of the electrical supply to the Pavilion. Once that has been done then dismantling of the Pavilion can start. The new bench adjacent to the play equipment has been installed and looks very nice. Quotes are being obtained for repair to path at the Wades Way entrance to the playing field and Councillor Hurst is going to repair the Basket Ball Hoop backing board.

It was agreed that the Clerk would obtain quotes for the repair of the loker adjacent to Knapton road allotments. Once this is done the Council will decide what must be done to prevent damage in the future.

Various reports from this month's meeting have been posted in the Documents section of the Parish Council website and in the News section, I have included a notification of a temporary road closure on Mundesley Road at the junction with Gunthorpe Lane. The closure is scheduled for 23 May to 2 June but will be open for access. The new website is not ready yet so we are still using the old one, www.trunchparishcouncil.norfolkparishes.gov.uk
