

Trunch Parish Council

The June meeting of Trunch Parish Council was held in the Methodist Church Meeting Room on Friday 10th June. It was attended by nine Parish Councillors and three members of the public.

The meeting was held later than usual due to our Clerk being unwell. The minutes will also be late as she is in Hospital. So this report will be brief.

The main point of discussion at the meeting concerned the Playing Field. A group of youths, not all from Trunch, have been congregating on the field in the evenings. Skate board accessories (ramps etc) have been placed on the hardstanding adjacent to the basketball hoop. There are reports of drinking, smoking and foul language being used. Rubbish, eg cans lighters etc, just dumped on the ground in the area. Young children are being intimidated.

With regard to the skate board equipment, it was decided to move it into the pavilion for safe keeping. The Parish Council is responsible for the Playing Field and all equipment on the field must be registered with them and covered by their insurance. If not, in the event of an accident, they would be liable.

Regarding the rubbish, there is no excuse for throwing it on the ground, there is a rubbish bin nearby. Several Parish Councillors, and members of the public regularly tidy up in this area and the amount that they clear up has to be seen to be believed. (There are photographs available)

If you see any antisocial behaviour taking place, anywhere in the village, please report it to the Police.
