

Trunch Parish Council

The January meeting of Trunch Parish Council was held on Wednesday 6th January 2016. It was attended by ten Parish Councillors, Mr N Coppack of NNDC , Mr W Northam of NCC and one member of the public.

NNDC Councillor Coppack said the members of the public and Parish Councillors can contact him with any problems and his contact details are on the NNDC website. He also agreed to investigate what can be done about the lack of mobile phone signal in the area, and Trunch in particular.

The Clerk reported that the electricity supply will be removed from the playing field pavilion this month and once that is done, work can commence on dismantling the building.

Last month I reported that the Playing Field steering Group is being dissolved and that we would hold a public meeting between the Village Society, Parish Council and anyone else to discuss the way forward. That meeting has now been scheduled for Wednesday 24th February at 7:30pm in the Methodist Church Meeting Room. All are welcome so please come along with your ideas and suggestions.

The playing field play equipment has had its annual safety inspection and is ok, apart from a few minor things that are currently being sorted out. The report will shortly be available on the Parish Council website.

A member of the public has generously agreed to donate a bench seat to be placed by the play area .

Allotment holders have expressed concern over the state of the path adjacent to the allotments. This is due to vehicles accessing the horses in the field opposite. The track is not a public right of way, access being limited to allotment holders and the Pardon family (to access their field at the end of the path). The Clerk will write to the owners of the land to inform them of the Parish Council's concern.

Various potholes have been reported to NCC and a broken Give-Way sign and Quiet Lane sign on Brick Kiln Road.

The next Parish Council Meeting will take place on Wednesday 3rd of February 2016 at 7:30pm in the Methodist Church Meeting Room.
