The February meeting of Trunch Parish Council was held in the Methodist Church meeting room on Wednesday 3rd February. It was attended by ten Councillors and two members of the public.

With regard to the position of Dog Warden, We had a volunteer but due to the lethargy of NNDC in contacting him, he has withdrawn his offer.

Following complaints about the hedges from gardens on North Walsham road overhanging the footpath, the clerk, through NCC found that these were the responsibility of Victory Housing. When contacted they have stated that it is the responsibility of the tenants to trim the hedges. The Clerk will contact Victory Housing again and ask them to write to their tenants .

The Parish Council and the Village Society will be represented so please come along with your suggestions, ideas, etc.
