

Trunch Parish Council

The July meeting of Trunch Parish Council was held in the Methodist Church Meeting Room on Wednesday 6th July. It was attended by nine Parish Councillors and two members of the public.

Councillor Boughton reported on a Devolution Briefing by NCC that he had attended and gave Councillors a copy of the brief. Hopefully I will get a copy of this on the website soon.

Potholes continue to be reported and also the verges/hedges are very overgrown and in some cases are obscuring road signs. Also it appears that the solar cells on the speed sign situated near the Social Club need repositioning to capture the maximum amount of sunlight. All these points will be reported to NCC Highways dept.

The electricity has been disconnected from the Pavilion on the Playing Field and the building will shortly be demolished. A meeting has been arranged between the Parish Council and the Village Society to discuss the way forward on the Playing Field project. This will take place on Wednesday 23rd August at 7:30pm in the Methodist Church Meeting Room.

The Clerk will chase up the repair of the track adjacent to the Knapton road allotments. The owner of the field adjacent to the track refuses to acknowledge that her tenants are anyway responsible for the damage to the track and has subjected myself and several other councillors to abusive and libellous telephone conversations. The Clerk will write to the Diocese requesting a copy of the lease in order that legal advice can be sought. Once a copy has been obtained, the Clerk will arrange a meeting with the legal department at NNDC to discuss this matter. Subject to this, it is intended to install a lockable barrier at the beginning of the track, restricting access to those who do not have right of way.
