

Broadland Housing to start building 12 new homes at Cornish Avenue, Trunch

Broadland Housing is pleased to announce that it will start building a mixture of twelve houses and bungalows, consisting of 1, 2 and 3 bedrooms, on the site adjoining Cornish Avenue in June.

The scheme is to be built by John Youngs, a Norwich-based subsidiary of RG Carter Group and includes a mix of affordable rent and shared ownership homes. A site layout plan and architect's image of the finished development are attached.

The properties are due to be completed in Spring 2018, with the highway becoming known as Fullers Lane, in honour of fallen heroes named on the War Memorial.

Priority for the affordable homes will be given to local people with strong connections to Trunch and the immediately adjoining parishes. The homes will be advertised on the North Norfolk 'Your Choice Your Home' website prior to completion. Anyone wishing to apply will need to register in advance.
