

## **Trunch Parish Council**

A Meeting of the Trunch Parish Council was held in the Methodist Church Community Room on Wednesday 6th March. It was attended by the Clerk, eleven Councillors and two members of the public.

Details of the Local Plan will be made available by North Norfolk District Council on 17th May followed by a six week period of consultation. We should then know what they plan in the way of additional housing, if any, for Trunch.

The necessary work, to the trees around the perimeter of the playing field, recommended in the Inspection Report has been completed. Quotations for some additional tree work are being sought.

The work to improve the surface of the footpath between Brewery Road and Gimingham Road has been completed. The timber post 'chicane' at the Brewery Road end will be removed in line with North Norfolk District Council policy as reported last month

The deteriorating condition of pot holes in Gunthorpe Lane and at the junction of the North Walsham Road and Cornish Road has, again, been reported to Norfolk County Council. Additional pot holes at Blooms Turn have also been reported. Please beware of the hazard they create.

In an endeavour to prevent drivers of larger vehicles using the playing field as a turning circle, a chain link barrier has been installed adjacent to the car park. The posts on the car park have been installed 3 metres apart allowing sufficient room for vehicles to manoeuvre on and off the car park.

It was agreed, in principle, to set up Task and Finish Groups to look at issues such as Parish Council policies, and allotments. These will be defined after the result of the Parish Elections when the new term of Office for Councillors starts.

A number of items of expenditure including the Clerk's salary, and tax were agreed for payment.
